



Client file setup info for Production

Digital Printing from file

Files supplied from Mac or Pc can be setup in:

Quark Express files must be setup at quarter, half or finale size, working within a maximum page area of 1219.2mm.

Supplied complete with placed images and fonts.

Don't forget to add bleed to your images outside the page area, About 5mm.

Placed Images

Photoshop

Placed images should be supplied saved as CMYK files as either an EPS or TIFF.

Recommended file size, working at the finished size, should be no lower than 150dpi.

Suggested file saving as EPS with the preview set to JPEG and the quality set to Jpeg Maximum quality to reduce the size in MB on your disk.

Illustrator

Placed images should be supplied as CMYK EPS files.

Files from PC

CorelDraw Files should be supplied as CMYK, exported as an EPS with text saved as curves.

Cut Out Lettering

Illustrator/CorelDraw

Files should be supplied as .AI version 5 with all text converted to outlines

Files supplied from PC or Mac :

All text needs to be converted to outlines or the font/s supplied

(Note that images supplied as poor quality artwork or low resolution bitmaps which require Photoshop work to produce a clean outline will incur additional costs).

Print and Profile Cut

In addition to the above requirements, all images supplied for printing with a profile cut should be supplied with a profile path generated around the object to be cut.
